

2018 Bar Stool Open Rules

No carry-in alcohol. Please support our host, the Grand Lake Restaurants and Bars!

1. Teams must start at the bar where they signed up. Only the BSO Chairperson may grant exceptions to this rule. *Teams may visit any bar at random but must complete all bars by 6:00pm to be eligible for prizes.*
2. **Play begins with a shotgun start at 9:00 a.m. and must be completed, with your scorecard turned in at your last hole, by 6:00 p.m.** Contestants in line to play a hole may complete that hole, even if time has expired.
3. Each team must be made up of four players, no more and no less. One player may not play for another player. Players will furnish their own ball and putter.
4. There will be no practice shots. There is a four stroke maximum per person per hole. Pick up after the third shot.
5. All balls hit "out of bounds" will result in a one stroke penalty and be placed back in play no closer to the hole than where it went out, with a one club head distance from the boundary.
6. Lowest team score wins. In the event of a tie, money will be divided evenly. All rulings by the official judges will be final.
7. Judging for the Pontoon and T-shirt Contests will be at Celina Eagles. Winners will be announced and prizes awarded for the Bar Stool Open, the BSO Pontoon Contest at **2 p.m. Sunday, Aug.12, 2018 at Celina Eagles.**

IMPORTANT: Teams engaging in any type of water fights or inappropriate conduct will be disqualified and banned from further competition and future events. This will be strictly enforced.
